MHD is Designed to fit within the Ofsted common inspection framework for further education and skills, the website includes resources covering every unit within the curriculum and has been designed to replace all of the outdated materials such as books and DVDs, using a user-friendly and intuitive interface designed with colours and fonts sympathetic to those with dyslexia and/or dyspraxia. Once a user is logged-in, they will be able to navigate through the entire site without extended hours of instruction.

For the first time students and tutors have access to a constantly updated and complete educational library, which can be accessed anytime and anywhere, as long as the user has Internet access. The library is available to over 4,400 desktop and mobile devices and features internationally recognised contributors, such as Tim Hartley, Patrick Cameron, Josh Woods, Stacey Broughton, John Vial and many more.

For work-based learners and their employers, the MHD allows employers to standardise their delivery of foundation techniques to for those being taught within the workplace a learner supplements their college time with home-based study to develop strong foundation skills and help learners maintain employment or progress to courses leading to higher-level qualifications.

- Step 1 – Student will be required to attend an induction at the training academy followed by which MHD access and an educator will be assigned directly to the student within the work placement.
- Step 2 – Depending upon the student and the salons needs the educator will attend meetings on a weekly or fortnightly basis with the learner within the workplace.
- Step 3 – On the first session that the educator attends they will be given a log book along with a demonstration of MHD.
- Step 4 – The Educator/Assessor will be setting assignments, revision work using the MHD system and working alongside the learner with regular email and telephone contact. Timelines given for all assignments, revision deadlines must be met by the learner.
- Step 5 – Practical training is offered by the work placement team and it is the learner's responsibility to keep the educator informed of any additional practical training needs that they may require. While the practical training is heavily reliant upon the work placement team the Educator can offer additional sessions and support within this area where requested.
- Step 6 – Our Educators will set up an action plan to assess practical skills on a regular basis throughout the course qualification. 50% of practical assessments within any unit can be obtained by witness statements of which will be explained in more depth by your educator on there first visit.
- Step 7 – Online testing we will bring a computer in to your work placement on planned dates for you to complete all relevant online tests. Arrangements can be made for testing to be sat within the Academy or a local library should this be required
