Have you thought about hiring an apprentice but thought you couldn't afford to take one on?

FUNDING

The government is changing how apprentices work, and from October 2016 the minimum wage for apprentices will be:

Apprentices aged 16 - 19 Years:

30 hours to include an 8 hour training day. Minimum contracts of 16 hours are only acceptable where an apprentice holds a personal valid reason to not being in a position full time i.e. a working parent, carer or guardian at the apprentice rate currently £3.40 and in April 2017 increased to £3.50

Apprentices aged 19 & over:

Are exempt from national minimum wage and can therefore work for the apprenticeship minimum wage of £3.40 for the first 12 months of their apprenticeship employment.
